

Thank you for partnering with us to reach the people of Cambodia with the Gospel of Jesus!



We have officially been in Cambodia for a **whole month!** It has been a full and exciting time of settling in, starting new routines, and seeing God work in amazing ways. If you've wondered what life has looked like for the Wrights this past month, here's a glimpse into our journey!

Arya started school and absolutely LOVES it! Meanwhile, both of us have begun language school. Learning Khmer is no small task, but we are making progress! Here's a little taste of what we've been learning: ជំរាបសួរ, យើងជា Wrights, សូមព្រះជាមា្លស់ប្រទានពរអ្នក។ (Hello, we are the Wrights, may God bless you!) Right now, we are focusing on conversational Khmer and will begin reading and writing soon. Language school is 20 hours a week, plus plenty of homework, and we are also working with a tutor to help us learn as effectively as possible.

This past month, we've also had the joy of building and strengthening relationships with our fellow ministry partners here in Cambodia. **We are so thankful for the friendships and support** of our fellow workers here, like the Donovans and Rogers, as well as our national partners, Pilot and Seylah. We've been attending a wonderful international church most weeks and also joining our Khmer partners for church in the local language at times. It has been a blessing to be part of a strong, faithful community of believers who are passionately serving Christ!

One of the biggest challenges we've faced this month is the **delay in receiving our shipment** of items from the U.S. Originally scheduled to arrive when we landed on January 10th, it has now been delayed close to two months due to logistical issues. As of now, it is scheduled to arrive by the first week of March. This shipment contains many of our essential belongings kids' beds, toys, musical instruments, clothes, and other household items that will help make our house feel like home. **Please pray** with us that everything arrives soon and undamaged!
