Dear Friends and Partners,

Thank you so much for your continued prayers and faithful support for our family and ministry here in Cambodia. It is such an encouragement to know that **we are not serving alone**, but that you are lifting us up in prayer and partnering with us in the work God is doing here.

One of the biggest answers to prayer has been for **Pastor Hang**. Many of you were praying for him as he has been very sick over the past months. We are thankful to share that he is doing better—he is now **able to walk** around and continue carrying out his pastoral responsibilities. This is a huge blessing, and we praise God for His healing and sustaining grace in Pastor Hang's life.

We also continue to ask you to pray for Pastor Pilot and his wife Seylah and the financial needs for the children's home and church planting ministry. We have seen God begin to open doors—there have been some meaningful connections made and several one-time and short-term partnerships come in. **We are thankful for how God is providing**, and we are continuing to **pray for long-term** monthly, quarterly, or yearly partners to help sustain this ministry. Another great encouragement has been our weekly ministry in the KPC village. It has been a joy to serve alongside the Donovan and the Nhap families, and we are seeing people from Cham Muslim backgrounds come to **know Christ and begin following Him**. This is such a powerful reminder of how the Gospel is reaching into places that once seemed closed, and we ask that you continue praying for this ministry each week.

Language has also been a huge area of growth. We have now completed Level 6 of language school and will be taking a short break before beginning Levels 7 and 8. By God's grace, we are now able to have regular conversations and are beginning to communicate more clearly. I also had the opportunity this past Sunday to **preach fully in Khmer** without a translator. It was such an encouragement to see a year of hard work beginning to bear fruit. Thank you for your prayers for this area of ministry—we truly feel them.

Another unique opportunity God has given is through social media. Some of you may have seen videos we've been posting, and through those platforms we now have a growing audience of over 150,000 people. While many of the videos are simple and focused on daily life or culture, we intentionally include our faith and speak about Christ. We've already had the opportunity to **share about Jesus** from connections made this way. On a personal note, we are also excited that **Philip's mom, stepdad, and sister are visiting us for about a month**. This is a huge encouragement for our family, and we are so thankful to the Lord for His constant provision!
