Thank you SO Much for your **support** and your **prayers!** September was a month **filled with blessings.** We were able to spend the first two weeks at our home Church, New Life Baptist Church in Wabash, IN. Right after church on September 10th **Philip and Pastor Scott left for Cambodia** to do the leadership training that we have been asking for prayer for, you will hear more about that later in this letter! Philip arrived home at about 5 pm on Sept. 21st and we had a missions conference starting that evening at Liberty Baptist Church in Sweetser, IN! We had a wonderful opportunity to share our **passion for reaching the lost in Cambodia** and were able to make some great connections with the people from Liberty.

You have been **praying for the Cambodia Leadership Training** in September and God did some amazing things during this time. During the 4 days of leadership training at two separate provinces in Cambodia there were over **20** church planters, another **25-30** men who feel like God is calling them into ministry, and another **30** men & women who want to serve God and be involved in ministry any way that they can be. God is working in Cambodia in a mighty way and calling people to **reach their own communities with the Gospel**, Praise the Lord!

During these couple of weeks of training Philip gained a better understanding of what his part of the ministry will look like in Cambodia. There are **men who are hungry** to do the work that God has called them to and need solid **biblical training.** We are humbled to be able to help equip men to **plant churches** and reach their community for Christ.

We want to introduce you to **Pastor Heang.** Pastor Heang lives in a village of about 500 families. At the age of about 65 **Heang accepted Jesus Christ** as his savior. Heang then took the gospel to his village where he was the **ONLY believer.** Heang got connected with Pastor Pilot and asked him if he was too old to be a pastor. Pastor Pilot responded that **if God has called you,** you are never too old to be a pastor and began doing Bible training with him. Now, at the age of 73 Pastor Heang has been able to **reach over 40 families** in his village with the Gospel and his 15 year old granddaughter leads Sunday School for 40+ children every week, Praise God!

We are seeing many blessings in Cambodia already, and **we cannot wait to arrive** on the field and step full-time into the ministry there. Deputation has been slightly stressful of course, but incredibly rewarding as we see many more people hearing about, gaining a burden, and praying for what God is doing in Cambodia. **God is moving in Cambodia.**
