Dear Friends and Partners,

Thank you again for your constant love, prayers, and support for our family and ministry here in Cambodia. We are incredibly grateful for all of you who continue to stand behind us and make it possible for us to serve here. It is hard to believe that we are already beginning to look ahead toward our furlough next year!

I will actually be back in the States for a few days this month and will be attending the BBFI National Meeting in Boston. If any of our supporting pastors are going to be there, I would love the opportunity to say hello and personally thank you for everything you have done for our family. We are also continuing to work on our furlough schedule for next year. We already have several churches planned to visit and are praying for 5–6 more new churches that we can schedule during our time back in the States.

Ministry here continues to move forward. Recently, seven more people placed their faith in Christ in the village where we minister each week. We are thankful for every opportunity the Lord gives us to share the Gospel and continue building relationships in these communities.

Our weekly Bible and pastoral training is also going very well. Some of you may remember us mentioning Pastor Bory and his wife, Dailin, in previous updates. Pastor Bory grew up in Pilot and Seila's children's home and now pastors a church in Kampong Speu. We are excited that he is beginning to work alongside us more closely. He will be helping with our Bible Training Center for our pastoral and leadership training programs. One of our goals has always been not simply to teach, but to work alongside Cambodian pastors and leaders who can help train others, so we are excited to see how the Lord continues to develop this partnership.

On the family side, homeschool has been going well. Now that we are completely finished with formal language school, we have really enjoyed having more time together as a family and a little more flexibility in our schedule. It has been a blessing to enter this season where we can devote more of our time to ministry, tighten our focus, and begin making plans for what our next term in Cambodia will look like.
